The Prize will be awarded to a young researcher <u>born 1981 or later</u> for the best scientific work in the field of arrhythmias, pacing and electrophysiology, in basic sciences or clinical sciences, <u>published</u> recently (since 1st of November 2020) as <u>first</u> (or co-first) author in a <u>peer reviewed journal or in-press</u>, for scientific work that has been <u>primarily performed in Switzerland</u>. A researcher can only submit <u>one</u> research paper.

The amount of the SwissRhythm Research Prize is 5'000 Swiss Francs.

It is important to note that the SwissRhythm Research Prize is intended to be awarded to a nominee based on the scientific value of the submitted work, and not on the scientific profile, previous achievements or future potential of the applicant or his/her team.

All researchers are invited to submit their scientific papers and a short cover letter by email to info@pacemaker.ch prior to the application deadline at 23:59 on Monday, October 25, 2021.
